The result is an incredible miscellany of information that appeals to both the scientific community and the curious.

I Twenty-five years ago, at the Conference on the Comparative Reception of Darwinism held at the University of Texas in 1972, only two countries of the Iberian world-Spain and Mexico-were represented.' At the time, it was apparent that the topic had attracted interest only as regarded the "mainstream" science countries of Western Europe, plus the United States. The Eurocentric bias of professional history of science was a fact. The sea change that subsequently occurred in the historiography of science makes 1972 appear something like the antediluvian era. Still, we would like to think that that meeting was prescient in looking beyond the mainstream science countries-as then perceived-in order to test the variation that ideas undergo as they pass from center to periphery. One thing that the comparative study of the reception of ideas makes abundantly clear, however, is the weakness of the center/periphery dichotomy from the perspective of the diffusion of scientific ideas. Catholics in mainstream countries, for example, did not handle evolution much better than did their coreligionaries on the fringes. Conversely, Darwinians in Latin America were frequently better placed to advance Darwin's ideas in a social and political sense than were their fellow evolutionists on the Continent. The Texas meeting was also a marker in the comparative reception of scientific ideas, Darwinism aside. Although, by 1972, scientific institutions had been studied comparatively, there was no antecedent for the comparative history of scientific ideas.

Edward fled to Flanders where he gathered support and invaded England in March 1471. After some victories at the battles of Barnet and Tewkesbury he resumes the throne

Henry VI was found dead in the Tower of London probably assassinated

Edward reigned in relative peace for the next twelve years

Edward's health began to fail and he became subject to an increasing number of ailments. His physicians attributed this in part to a habitual use of emetics

He fell fatally ill at Easter 1483 and died on 9 April 1483

His brother was Richard Duke of Gloucester

His twelve-year-old son, Edward V was never crowned, and Gloucester became King Richard II
