The Divine Vision of Dante's Paradiso

Manuscript Poetics explores the interrelationship between the material features of textual artifacts and the literary aspects of the medieval Italian texts they preserve. This original study is both an investigation into the material foundations of literature and a reflection on notions of textuality, writing, and media in late medieval and early modern Italy. Francesco Marco Aresu examines the book-objects of manuscripts and early printed editions, asking questions about the material conditions of production, circulation, and reception of literary works. He invites scholars to reconcile reading with seeing (and with touching) and to challenge contemporary presumptions about technological neutrality and the modes of interfacing and reading. Manuscript Poetics investigates the correspondences between textuality and materiality, content and medium, and visual-verbal messages and their physical support through readings of Dante Alighieri's *Vita nova*, Giovanni Boccaccio's *Teseida*, and Francesco Petrarca's *canzoniere* (*Rerum vulgarium fragmenta*). Aresu shows that Dante, Boccaccio, and Petrarca evaluated and deployed the tools of scribal culture to shape, signal, or layer meanings beyond those they conveyed in their written texts. Medieval texts, Aresu argues, are uniquely positioned to provide this perspective, and they are foundational to the theoretical understanding of new forms and materials in our media-saturated contemporary world.

Handbook of the History of the Philosophy of Law and Social Philosophy

Dante, Artist of Gesture proposes a visual technique for reading Dante's Comedy, suggesting that the reader engages with Dante's striking images of souls as if these images were arranged in an architectural space. Art historians have shown how series of discrete images or scenes in medieval places of worship, such as the mosaics in the Baptistery of San Giovanni in Florence or the frescoes in the Scrovegni Chapel in Padua, establish not only narrative sequences but also parallelisms between registers, forging links between those registers by the use of colour and gestural forms. Heather Webb takes up those techniques to show that the Comedy likewise invites the reader to make visual links between disparate, non-sequential moments in the text. In other words, Webb argues that Dante's poem asks readers to view its verbally articulated sequences of images with a set of observational tools that could be acquired from the practice of engaging with and meditating on the bodily depictions of vice and virtue in fresco cycles or programmes of mosaics in places of worship. One of the most inherently visible aspects of the Comedy is the representation of signature gestures of the characters described in each of the realms. This book traces described gestures and bodily signs across the canticles of the poem to provide a key for identifying affective and devotional itineraries within the text.

"Building on recent Petrarch scholarship and broader studies of medieval poetics, poetic narrativity and biblical intertextuality, this study argues that Petrarch's *Rerum vulgarium fragmenta* is an ordered and coherent work unified by narrative and theological structures. The author begins with the premise that the multiple voices of the Petrarchan figure (or subject) call for a reading informed by historical and autobiographical considerations. Within such a reading, the internal chronology of the work coincides with a temporal framework provided by Petrarch's Latin prose and poetry. Drawing on this material, he argues that Petrarch's derivations from early poets in the Italian vernacular, his Augustinianism and his humanism are manifest in the *Fragmenta* and contribute to its narrative and theological unity."--

Dante's New Lives

Il 2021 è, come noto, il settimo centenario della morte di Dante. Ma anche il secondo centenario della morte di Napoleone (per cui Manzoni compose il 5 maggio; e nel 1821 terminò anche l'Adelchi e intraprese la stesura del Fermo e Lucia). E sempre nel 1821 Hegel pubblicò i Lineamenti di filosofia del diritto. Questo scritto di Massimo Campanini, consegnato all'editore proprio il giorno prima della sua improvvisa scomparsa, il 9 ottobre 2020, riannoda le tre ricorrenze lungo il filo del rapporto tra religione e storia, che in tre grandi autori pur così diversi, che si volevano e si professavano esplicitamente cristiani, appare sempre altamente aporetico e problematico, poiché in loro la religione entra sempre in rapporto dialettico con la società di appartenenza. Una aporeticità che apre una finestra di comprensione dei motivi della crisi del mondo contemporaneo, anzi più esattamente dell'Occidente contemporaneo. L'imperdibile, suggestivo e brillante testamento intellettuale di un grande studioso.

Dante

Georg Simmel e Hans Kelsen sono figli di un tempo che hanno saputo interpretare anche in virtù di un'iniziazione rivolta al Magister mundi, Dante Alighieri: "araldo di un nuovo mondo", "poeta universale" che "parla eterno al cuore di tutti", superiore a qualsiasi altro poeta in quanto in lui "la poesia investe anche il contenuto" che riguarda la vita, ovvero l'agire e la politica. Dante di Shakespeare

The Oxford Handbook of Dante contains forty-four specially written chapters that provide a thorough and creative reading of Dante's oeuvre. Dante and the Dynamics of Textual Exchange is the first book-length study to explore the question of poetry and genre in Dante's Vita Nova (ca. 1292–1294). In paying particular attention to complex and multifaceted interactions between different cultures in Italy in the thirteenth century, this study illuminates the multicultural and plurilinguistic society transitioning from the feudal court to the modern city-state, advanced by the rising mercantile class. Dante and the Dynamics of Textual Exchange

Every human being knows that we are walking through life following trails, whether we are aware of them or not. Medieval poets, from the anonymous composer of *Beowulf* to Marie de France, Hartmann von Aue, Gottfried von Strassburg, and Guillaume de Lorris to Petrarch and Heinrich Kaufringer, predicated their works on the notion of the trail and elaborated on its epistemological function. We can grasp here an essential concept that determines much of medieval and early modern European literature and philosophy, addressing the direction which all protagonists pursue, as powerfully illustrated also by the anonymous poets of *Herzog Ernst* and *Sir Gawain and the Green Knight*. Dante's *Divina Commedia*, in fact, proves to be one of the most explicit poetic manifestations of the fundamental idea of the trail, but we find strong parallels also in powerful contemporary works such as Guillaume de Deguileville's *Pèlerinage de la vie humaine* and in many mystical tracts.

Templa serena: studi in onore di Enrico Flores

Self-reflection, as the hallmark of the modern age, originates more profoundly with Dante than with Descartes. This book rewrites modern intellectual history, taking Dante's lyrical language in *Paradiso* as enacting a Trinitarian self-reflexivity that gives a theological spin to the birth of the modern subject already with the Troubadours. The ever more intense self-reflexivity that has led to our contemporary secular world and its technological apocalypse can lead also to the poetic vision of other worlds such as those experienced by Dante. Facing the same nominalist crisis as Duns Scotus, his exact contemporary and the precursor of scientific method, Dante's thought and work indicate an alternative modernity along the path not taken. This other way shows up in Nicholas of Cusa's conjectural science and in Giambattista Vico's new science of imagination as alternatives to the exclusive reign of positive empirical science. In continuity with Dante's vision, they contribute to a reappropriation of self-reflection for the humanities.

Marco Santagata illuminates one of the world's supreme poets from many angles—philosopher, father, courtier, political partisan. Tracing the Trails in the Medieval World

Dante's *Paradiso* and the Theological Origins of Modern Thought

Il saggio *Dantes Psychologie* (*Psicologia di Dante*) pubblicato da Georg Simmel nel 1884, a pochi anni dalla laurea, non è l'ennesima speculazione filosofica tra le innumerevoli e prestigiose già esistenti sul sommo poeta; piuttosto porta alla luce questioni fondative tracciate nel percorso storico da Dante e che il giovane filosofo berlinese rileva dal sommerso. Da qui, la necessità di concentrarsi su un "ritratto" epocale creato ad arte da Simmel avvantaggiandosi delle parole di Dante e, soprattutto, ripercorrendo tutti i suoi capolavori. Il "viaggio", che si distingue in due sentieri, conduce – lungo il cammino esistenziale dell'uomo tra morte e rinascita vissuto dallo stesso Alighieri – alla meta finale della "conoscenza", passando per l'amore terreno e il divino nel desiderio di un "governo mondiale" e di una "lingua" unica. Simmel evidenzia le contraddizioni presenti nell'"Io" di Dante, consapevole sin da subito di aver rivolto lo sguardo a un "genio" che "è l'espressione più perfetta dello Spirito del tempo". Simmel raggiunge gli abissi di Dante e scandaglia con acume i meandri della sua anima servendosi delle "armi affilate" della filosofia e della psicologia della storia.
