By 1960, John Bennett was the youngest black inmate at Fort Leavenworth. His lost battle for clemency was fought between 2 vastly different presidential administrations—Eisenhower's and Kennedy's—as the civil rights movement was gaining steam. Drawing on interviews, trial transcripts, and rarely published archival material, Serrano brings to life the characters in this lost history: from desperate mothers and disheartened appeals lawyers, to the prison doctors, psychiatrists, and chaplains. He shines a light on the scandalous legal maneuvering that reached the doors of the White House and the disparity in capital punishment that was cut so strictly along racial lines.

Innocence and the Death Penalty

Virginia’s capital city knew poverty, injustice, slavery, vagrancy, substandard working conditions, street crimes, brutality, unsanitary conditions, and pandemics. One of the biggest stains in the city’s past was the spectacle of public executions, attended by throngs. Thousands, including the old and the very young, reveled in a carnival-like atmosphere. This book narrates the history of the executions—hangings, and during the Civil War also firing squads—that formed a large part of Richmond’s entertainment picture. Revulsion slowly mounted until the introduction of the electric chair. The history has a cast of unusual characters—the condemned, the crime victims, family members, the executioners, and not least an 182 pound “gallows” dog.

Public Executions in Richmond, Virginia

The working name of my story, *The Death Squads with Impunity: The Public Executions of Judi Bari, Mary Joe Frug and Linda Ann Raynor* may raise some eyebrows as being over the top or even insensitive, but I'll just briefly explain. There are so many disturbing aspects of this story it's difficult not to resort to name calling. Besides the fact the FBI'S Unabomber task force had its head up its ass by ganging up for 15 years against the only profilers that made sense. Add, the FBI San Francisco Field office refusal to investigate the Bari/Cherney bombing insisting on the fiction they were guilty of transporting a bomb when their own FBI lab found it was an motion-detection detonated anti-personal pipe bomb and it was obvious FBI SA FRANK DOYLE did more than lied, he participated in the crime. Fast forward ten months, when the FBI Santa Rosa office and the Mendocino Sherriff Department failed to respond to a Nationwide request from the Cambridge Police Department for information that would help them determine the motive of feminist Mary Joe Frugs execu- tion, even though the Lord's Avenger Letter was delivered in their area of responsibility (AO) and in case of the Mendocino Sheriff's Department the Lord's Avenger Letter was delivered in Ukiah their HQ. And It only gets worse, when Linda Ann Raynor of Santa Rosa (who had lived in West Santa Rosa at the same time as Judi Bari, also where the Old Santa Rosa Naval Airfield firebombing/attempted murder happened.) was executed in Connecticut on the first day of her visit there. Neither the Santa Rosa FBI office nor the Santa Rosa Police Dept. informed the Connecticut State Police about the opposition to her AIDS Hospice or the Lord's Avenger letter, resulting in a key piece of evidence a "Blue towel" being overlooked. A blue towel was used to wrap the Bari bomb but into this (Connecticut) blue towel the killer placed a pocket full of round stones into the center of the towel and swung it like a club killing her, so the CSP missed finding the blue towel. As for using the word "Executions" since it is the word cofounder of Christian Reconstructionism, Gary North uses to describe the capital punishment envisioned when they come to power. Stoning is the preferred biblical method of community executions.

The Death Penalty in Democratic and Republican States and its Effects on a State's Murder Rate

Mudgee was a small town west of the Blue Mountains where from the beginnings of settlement savagery reigned between First Nations and settlers. The town was ideally located for a Gaol and for punishment. Life was harsh and many found solace in alcohol which in a lot of cases, led to trouble. The Gaol was in the center of town and although surrounded by high walls did not block out the sounds of those being punished. Four men were convicted and hanged in Mudgee between 1875 and 1893 inside the 'new' Mudgee Gaol, three for murder and ones for rape. All paid the ultimate price. All were hanged by the state executioner, Robert Rice Howard, known as 'Nosey Bob'. Two of the men, George

Rope and George Pitt were builders of the gallows and the first two hanged on them. The story of the construction of the gallows is one not to be missed. This highly readable book walks the reader through the development of the town, law and order and gives a detailed account of crimes committed, the trials and finally the executions. The book fully researched by Helen Cottee and illustrated with many photographs, signatures, drawings and plans of buildings and crime scenes. The Gaol was demolished in the 1930's and the contents auctioned. Each chapter, where available finish with the family trees of those executed and of their victims. This book reveals the relative ease with which individuals who live at society's margins can be wrongfully convicted, and the extraordinary difficulty of correcting such a wrong once it occurs. Margaret Edds makes the chilling argument that some other "expendable men" almost certainly have been less fortunate than Washington. This, she writes, is "the secret, shameful underbelly" of America's retention of capital punishment. Such wrongful executions may not happen often, but anyone who doubts that innocent people have been executed in the United States should remember the remarkable series of events necessary to save Earl Washington Jr. from such a fate.

Excerpt from Recent Disturbances and Military Executions in Ceylon My principal object in the following Notes is to attract attention to the wrongs of the inhabitants of the Kandian Provinces in Ceylon; and the attempt to illustrate their early history and present position is in furtherance of the same purpose. Although I was summoned before the Committee of the House of Commons on Ceylon affairs, I had there only to answer such questions as were asked at me, and could be of comparatively little service to the cause I advocate - viz., justice, without unnecessary delay, to the Kandian people. Before parliament was prorogued last summer, twelve months had elapsed from the time that great slaughter had been made amongst the inhabitants of the Kandian country, by the military acting in aid of the civil power. This slaughter was followed by so-called martial law and military executions, of which I cannot perceive any justification in the "Papers relative to the affairs of Ceylon, presented to both Houses of Parliament by command of her Majesty, in February 1849" - commonly called the Blue Book. On the contrary, I see much on the part of the Ceylon government which requires explanation, and much which I believe it will be impossible to reconcile with sound policy, or to prove consistent with good faith and common justice. In Ceylon, from 1826 until 1837, I had many opportunities of acquiring information on the subjects hereafter referred to, and particularly when I was commandant, district judge, and government agent in Måtale - a district, the people of which suffered severely previous to and during the supercession of law in 1848, (p. 220, Ceylon Blue Book.)
