It wasn't until the next morning that they finally discovered the truth, and the alarm was sounded. But by then Shiratori was long gone. Now he had escaped. But things aren't always as they seem. Three days later he was caught trying to steal supplies from a hospital and just like that, he was back in the slammer. But this time for his escape attempt he was sentenced to life in prison. The preparation and the serving of miso soup depend on the taste, on the culture and on the ingredients we have at our disposal. There might be many ways of preparation, but the basic one is really simple and it can be made by anyone even by an amateur if she / he follows the instructions. Firstly, the stock is prepared by adding water and the ingredients for the stock such as niboshi, kombu, katsuobushi and / or hoshi-shiitake. Some other ingredients may also be used but they are optional and depend on the taste of the chef that prepares the soup.
