Excerpt from Model-Supported Case Studies for Management Education To understand where system dynamics models, especially models-with-cases, may contribute to management education, consider first how business policy and strategy are traditionally taught. The first conventions were held as special sections of conferences devoted to simulation or cybernetics.
