More and more students are moving into our old city every year, and the future could really be bright in the terms of culture, teaching, and research. "Mantua Humanistic Studies" would like to be a small – but maybe not useless – contribution to what could be a "second Renaissance" for the capital of the Gonzagas, offered by a small but active Scientific Publishing House which was born and still operates in this small but incredible town.

Despite the fact that it seems to represent an issue directly connected with the question of where legal history is heading today, it still has not been the object of a focused inquiry.
