The book contains over 160 papers, and is divided into 14 sections covering subject areas such as: health and clinical information systems; eHealth and telemedicine; big data and advanced analytics; and evidence-based health informatics, evaluation and education, among many others. The book will be of value to all those working in the field of health and interested in finding new ways to enable the collaboration of different scientific disciplines and the establishment of comprehensive methodological approaches.

Foundations of Health Services Research

Das Lehrbuch Versorgungsforschung richtet sich an Studierende, Lehrende und Forschende sowie Interessierte aus den Bereichen Versorgungspraxis, Forschungsförderung, Selbstverwaltung und Gesundheitspolitik. Es vermittelt einen vertiefenden Überblick über das Fach Versorgungsforschung und orientiert sich dazu an den aktuellen Empfehlungen für ein Kerncurriculum für das Fach. Das Buch beschreibt die zentralen Gegenstände der Versorgungsforschung (Patient:innen und das Gesundheitssystem), ihre Theorien und Methoden und gibt Antworten auf die Frage, wie Forschungsergebnisse in die Praxis umgesetzt werden können. Eine Beschreibung der verschiedenen Anwendungsfelder der Versorgungsforschung rundet das Buch ab. Die Herausgeber Holger Pfaff, Professor für Qualitätsentwicklung und Evaluation in der Rehabilitation an der Universität zu Köln und Studiengangsleitung des Masterstudiengangs Versorgungswissenschaft. Edmund A.M. Neugebauer, Seniorprofessor für Versorgungsforschung, ehem. Präsident und Geschäftsführer der Medizinischen Hochschule Brandenburg, Theodor Fontane (MHB). Nicole Ernstmann, Professorin für Versorgungsforschung an der Universität zu Köln und Studiengangsleitung des Masterstudiengangs Versorgungswissenschaft. Martin Härter, Professor für Medizinische Psychologie am Universitätsklinikum Hamburg-Eppendorf und wissenschaftlicher Leiter des Ärztlichen Zentrums für Qualität in der Medizin (ÄZQ), Berlin. Falk Hoffmann, Professor für Versorgungsforschung an der Carl von Ossietzky Universität Oldenburg und Studiengangsleitung des Masterstudiengangs Versorgungsforschung.

Eine unabdingbare Voraussetzung für die Beantwortung der Forschungsfragen der Versorgungsforschung sind das Vorhandensein und die Zugänglichkeit von umfassenden Daten hoher Qualität. Es ist davon auszugehen, dass die Versorgungsforschung in den kommenden Jahren auf der Verlinkung (Datenlinkage, „data linkage“), also der Verknüpfung mehrerer Datenquellen auf Basis von geeigneten gemeinsamen Schlüsselvariablen beruhen wird. In Deutschland werden umfassende Daten hoher Qualität routinemäßig gesammelt, allerdings sind diese für Forschungszwecke nur bedingt geeignet und eingeschränkt verfügbar. Daher liegt der Ursprung dieses Gutachtens in den Grundfragen, welche Fragestellungen der Versorgungsforschung im Ausland auf Basis besserer Daten besser beantwortet werden können, und auf welchen Wegen eine solche Verbesserung der Datengrundlage in Deutschland erzielt werden könnte. Fallbeispiele interessanter Verlinkungsansätze aus zwölf Ländern wurden identifiziert und anhand eines vordefinierten Konzeptes analysiert. Informationen wurden für alle Vergleichsländer bzw. Fallstudien zunächst auf Basis von öffentlich zugänglichen Quellen identifiziert. Anschließend wurde pro Land ein Profil erstellt und geeigneten Länderexperten zur Validierung und Ergänzung weitergeleitet. Das Gutachten stellt eine Übersicht der eingeschlossenen Fallstudien vor (Kapitel 3), sowie im Anhang wichtige Eckdaten pro Land und Fallstudie. Es folgen eine nähere Betrachtung der Möglichkeiten der Nutzung von Routinedaten (Kapitel 4), der Verlinkungsmöglichkeiten mit und ohne eindeutigem personenbezogenen Merkmal (Kapitel 5), der unterschiedlichen Zugriffswege für Forscher (Kapitel 6), der Ausgestaltung des Einsatzes von Daten aus elektronischen Patienten- bzw. Gesundheitsakten für die Forschung (Kapitel 7) und ein Zwischenfazit (Kapitel 8). Das Gutachten endet mit einer Wunschliste für mögliche regulatorische Änderungen in Anbetracht der aktuellen politischen Diskussion (Kapitel 9). Wichtig ist hier zu beleuchten, dass die thematisierten Fallstudien aus dem internationalen Vergleich wichtige Aspekte hervorheben, die für die Problematik in Deutschland von Bedeutung sein könnten. Neben dem Mehrwert von vergleichsmäßig einfach zugänglichen, umfangreiche(re)n Abrechnungsdaten, die schneller als in Deutschland vorliegen, sektorenübergreifende Analysen erlauben und personenbezogen mit Gesundheits- sowie auch mit Regionaldaten verknüpfbar sind, wird auch das Potential von Datenbanken beleuchtet, die auf Basis der routinemäßigen Dokumentation (i.d.R. elektronischen Gesundheitsakten) von Leistungserbringern entstehen. Eine Investition in diese Richtung kann nicht nur für das eigene Gesundheitssystem Einsichten ermöglichen, sondern auch die internationale Kooperation fördern und zur internationalen Sichtbarkeit wissenschaftlicher Exzellenz beitragen. Eine Nebeneinanderstellung der in Deutschland vorhandenen Datenbestände und der in anderen Ländern eingesetzten Daten deutet darauf hin, dass sich die Diskussion hierzulande an erster Stelle mit der Ausgestaltung der zur Verfügung stehenden Daten befassen sollte und ergänzend die Erfassung zusätzlicher Informationen bedenken kann. The availability and accessibility of comprehensive, high-quality data are indispensable prerequisites for effective health services research. It can be assumed in the coming years that health services research will increasingly be based on data linkage, i.e. the linking of several data sources based on suitable common key variables. In Germany, comprehensive high-quality data are routinely collected, but their suitability and availability for research purposes is limited. Therefore, the motivation for this report lies in the answering of two basic questions: which questions of health services research can be better answered abroad on the basis of better data, and in which ways such conditions could be achieved in Germany. Case studies of interesting linkage approaches from twelve countries were identified and analyzed based on a predefined conceptual framework. Information on all comparison countries or case studies was first identified from publicly available sources. Profiles were then created for each country and case study and forwarded to appropriate country experts for validation and completion. The report presents an overview of the included case studies (chapter 3), as well as key information per country and case study in the appendix. This is followed by a closer look at the possibilities of using routine data (chapter 4), linkage approaches with and without unique personal identifiers (chapter 5), the different access routes for researchers (chapter 6), options for using data from electronic patient or health records for research (chapter 7), and an interim conclusion (chapter 8). The report ends with a wish list for possible regulatory changes in light of the current policy debate in Germany (Chapter 9). It is important to underline here that case studies from the international comparison were selected to highlight important aspects that could be relevant to the challenges in Germany. In addition to the added value of comparatively easily accessible, extensive claims data, which are available more quickly than in Germany, allow cross-sector analyses and can be linked to health data and regional data on a person-by-person basis, the potential of databases created on the basis of the routine documentation of service providers (usually electronic health records) is also discussed. Investing in this direction can not only provide insights for a country's own healthcare system, but also promote international cooperation and contribute to the international

visibility of scientific excellence. A juxtaposition of the data sets available in Germany and those used in other countries suggests that the discussion in Germany should focus first and foremost on optimizing the availability and accessibility of existing data and consider new approaches to the collection of additional information as a supplement.

Exploring Complexity in Health: An Interdisciplinary Systems Approach

Das deutsche Gesundheitswesen steht vor Herausforderungen, die es aufgrund wachsender Probleme rasch zu bewältigen gilt: der demografische Wandel mit der damit einhergehenden Multimorbidität von alternden Menschen, der sich verschärfende Fachkräftemangel, der dem Pflegebedarf nicht mehr gerecht werden kann sowie die Frage nach der Finanzierbarkeit des Gesundheitswesens stehen dabei als Triebfedern der Veränderung im Vordergrund. Ein zukunftsorientiertes Versorgungsmanagement mit Instrumentarien und Methoden, die diesen Problemen entgegentreten, kann hier Abhilfe schaffen. Intersektorale Ansätze wie die Hausarztzentrierte Versorgung oder strukturierte Behandlungsprogramme werden anhand von Modellprojekten einschließlich ihrer ökonomischen und juristischen Hemmnisse umfassend vorgestellt. Auch die fortschreitende Digitalisierung im Gesundheitswesen mit der Telematikinfrastruktur, der elektronischen Patientenakte sowie der Standardisierung und Strukturierung von Gesundheitsdaten stehen im Fokus des Bandes. Das vorliegende Buch stellt ein Grundlagenwerk dar, das gleichzeitig das bestehende Versorgungsmanagement skizziert sowie neue Perspektiven für die Regelversorgung aufzeigt. Mit Beispielen aus der Praxis und Aufgaben zur Selbstüberprüfung wird interessierten Lesern und Leserinnen sowie Fachpraktikern und -praktikerinnen die Welt des Versorgungsmanagements nähergebracht.

Versorgungsforschung

Die Leitlinie zeichnet sich durch einen diagnoseübergreifenden Ansatz für die Behandlung von Menschen mit schweren psychischen Störungen aus. Diese Patienten leiden hauptsächlich an den Auswirkungen einer schweren und längerfristigen psychischen Erkrankung. Für die Leitlinie wurden die Empfehlungen der Deutschen Gesellschaft für Psychiatrie, Psychotherapie und Nervenheilkunde (DGPPN) berücksichtigt.

Internationale Datengrundlagen für die Versorgungsforschung – Impulse für Deutschland

Die AutorInnen dieses Bandes beleuchten die systembildende, systemverändernde und systemüberdauernde strukturelle Wirkung von (Versorgungs-)Netzwerken im Falle von Krankheit und Pflege. Dabei wird deutlich: Durch Vernetzung geschieht Evolution! Einerseits in der Innenperspektive, weil Vernetzung strukturelle Kopplung verschiedener Akteure aus den Sektoren Markt, Staat, Dritter Sektor und Infomeller Sektor ermöglicht. Andererseits in der Außenperspektive, weil sich das Versorgungsnetzwerk mit seiner Umwelt verbindet und auf unterschiedliche Versorgungsbedarfe flexibel reagieren kann. Vernetzte Strukturen ermöglichen somit, komplexe Versorgungsfragen effektiver und effizienter zu bearbeiten.

Zukunftsorientiertes Versorgungsmanagement

Das Buch liefert einen umfassenden Überblick über das neue Forschungsgebiet E-Health-Ökonomie und zeigt den aktuellen Stand der Diskussion in Wissenschaft, Praxis und Politik auf. Gesundheitsökonomie, Gesundheitswirtschaft, Gesundheitsversorgung sowie ambulante, stationäre, sektorenübergreifende Versorgung und die Erstellung von Leistungen am Gesundheitsstandort der privaten Haushalte: E-Health ist heute und besonders in Zukunft, einhergehend mit weiteren technologischen Innovationen, von großer Bedeutung. Mit dem neuen E-Health-Gesetz findet das Buch den Bezug zur aktuellen politischen Auseinandersetzung und bietet mit seinen ökonomischen Artikeln einen Beitrag für die Diskussion um Nutzen und Mehrwert von Informationstechnologie in der Gesundheitswirtschaft. Praktiker und Wissenschaftler aus Medizin, Informatik und (Gesundheits-)Ökonomie sind genauso angesprochen wie alle weiteren Akteure, welche sich mit der Ökonomie des Einsatzes von IT in der Gesundheitswirtschaft beschäftigen. Lehrenden und Studierenden gibt das Buch einen umfassenden Überblick. Das Buch bietet sich aufgrund seiner Struktur als Gesamtlektüre genauso an wie die selektive Wahl einzelner thematischer Kapitel oder auch einzelner Beiträge der verschiedenen Autoren.

S3-Leitlinie Psychosoziale Therapien bei schweren psychischen Erkrankungen

Zahlreiche Studien haben in den letzten Jahren den Tatbestand der gesundheitlichen Ungleichheit belegt. Unklar ist bislang, inwieweit spezifische soziale Gruppen ungleich von der Rehabilitation profitieren und welche Rolle individuelle und behandlungsspezifische Faktoren dabei spielen. Am Beispiel der onkologischen und psychischen/psychosomatischen Rehabilitation wird diese Frage in der vorliegenden Arbeit untersucht. Dazu wird das Soziallagenkonzept für den Versorgungssektor anwendbar gemacht. Die Untersuchung soll zur Diskussion von Versorgungsungleichheiten in Deutschland beitragen.

Evolution durch Vernetzung

Auf Basis theoretischer Überlegungen und Daten einer bundesweiten Befragung zeigt der Autor, dass durch Post Market Surveillance generiertes Wissen in F&E-Abteilungen von Medizinprodukte-Herstellern wertvolle Impulse für Neuprodukte bzw. die stetige Verbesserung bereits vorhandener Produkte und -prozesse bieten kann. Darauf aufbauend gibt er praxisnahe Empfehlungen für Hersteller zur Umsetzung eines strategischen Post Market-Managements in den Bereichen EDV, Organisation und Personalmanagement, um somit den Anforderungen des sich intensivierenden Wettbewerbs in der Medizintechnik durch innovative Ideen begegnen zu können.

E-Health-Ökonomie

Die pharmazeutische Industrie steht im deutschen Gesundheitswesen häufig im Mittelpunkt kontroverser Kostendiskussionen. Als Resultat zielten die Maßnahmen der Gesundheitspolitik in den letzten Jahren vorrangig auf (Kosten-)regulierungen der Arzneimittelindustrie ab, deren bisheriger Höhepunkt die Einführung des AMNOG im Jahr 2011 darstellte. Die bis dato freie Preisbildung wurde abgelöst durch ein zweistufiges Verfahren bestehend aus Nutzenbewertung und Preisverhandlung. Diese gravierenden Veränderungen der gesetzlichen Rahmenbedingungen für die Arzneimittelindustrie hatten einen erheblichen Bedeutungszuwachs des Themas Market Access zur Folge. Die Motivation zur Erstellung des Buches ist es, eine Publikation zu schaffen, die nicht nur den aktuellen Status widerspiegelt, sondern vielmehr auch die wesentlichen Instrumente und Verfahrensweisen aufzeigt und auch kritisch hinterfragt. Der Leser soll so einen Einblick in die Materie als auch nötiges Rüstzeug bei der konkreten Umsetzung erlangen. Das Buch dient dazu, Market Access Managern oder Interessierten fundiertes Hintergrundwissen zu vermitteln.

Soziale Arbeit in der Psychiatrie. Lehrbuch

Welche Einschränkungen verbleiben im Alltag trotz einer Cochlea-Implantat-Versorgung? Mit welchen Vorurteilen und Ausgrenzungen sehen sich hörgeschädigte Menschen täglich konfrontiert? Was für eine Bedeutung haben Selbsthilfegruppen bei der Bewältigung von Hörbeeinträchtigungen? In der rekonstruierenden, qualitativen Studie von 50 Cochlea-Implantat-Träger*innen werden von Sascha Roder die Rehabilitationserfahrungen, die private und berufliche Teilhabe sowie das Musikverstehen untersucht. Unter Einbezug der Theorie der Disability Studies, interpretativer soziologischer Ansätze, dem Capability Approach sowie der Biopolitik wird in diesem Buch eine kritische Analyse der aktuellen Teilhabesituation von Menschen mit einer Hörprothese vorgenommen.

Soziale Ungleichheit in der rehabilitativen Versorgung

Ziel des vorliegenden Bandes ist es, eine interdisziplinäre Sicht auf die derzeitigen rasanten Phänomene räumlicher Disparitäten in der Sicherstellung der Grundinfrastruktur von Bildung, Verkehr, Nahversorgung, Gesundheit etc. global, aber auch in regionalen Strukturen zu entwickeln. Dorothee Christiane Meinzer geht in ihrer qualitativen Studie der Frage nach, wie sich die kommunikative Konstruktion der Arzt-Patient-Beziehung in einer zunehmend digitalisierten Welt vollzieht. Im Zuge mehrtägiger Feldaufenthalte in allgemeinmedizinischen Praxen wurde die Kommunikation am Empfang, in Wartebereichen und in Sprechstunden beobachtet. Zudem wurden Interviews mit

Hausärzten und Patienten geführt. Anhand der empirisch gewonnenen Daten zeigt die Autorin, wie die Kommunikation zwischen Ärzten und Patienten über Medien vermittelt, durch Medien gestützt und auf Medien bezogen verläuft. Es wird deutlich, dass Medien die Arzt-Patient-Beziehung nicht gleichförmig prägen. So werden fünf Patiententypen identifiziert, die ihre Beziehung auf je spezifische Weise konstruieren.
