The Goddess and the Sun in Indian Myth

In analyzing the parallels between myths glorifying the Indian Great Goddess, Durg , and those glorifying the Sun, Skrya, found in the M rkaG eya Pur Ga, this book argues for an ideological ecosystem at work in the M rkaG eya Pur Ga privileging worldly values, of which Indian kings, the Goddess (Dev+), the Sun (Skrya), Manu and M rkaG eya himself are paragons. This book features a salient discovery in Sanskrit narrative text: just as the M rkaG eya Pur Ga houses the Dev+ M h tmya glorifying the supremacy of the Indian Great Goddess, Durg , it also houses a Skrya M h tmya, glorifying the supremacy of the Sun, Skrya, in much the same manner. This book argues that these m h tmyas were meaningfully and purposefully positioned in the M rkaG eya Pur Ga, while previous scholarship has considered this haphazard interpolation for sectarian aims. The book demonstrates that deliberate compositional strategies make up the Saura–Z kta symbiosis found in these mirrored m h tmyas. Moreover, the author explores what he calls the "dharmic double helix" of Brahmanism, most explicitly articulated by the structural opposition between prav[tti (worldly) and niv[tti (other-worldly) dharmas. As the first narrative study of the Skrya M h tmya, along with the first study of the M rkaG eya Pur Ga (or any Pur Ga), as a narrative whole, this book will be of interest to academics in the field of Religion, Hindu Studies, South Asian Studies, Goddess Studies, Narrative Theory and Comparative Mythology.

The Heart of the Goddess

This book is devoted to the study of the bilingual "parallel poems" of Ludwig Strauss (Aachen 1892 × Jerusalem 1953) created between 1934 and 1952 in Palestine/Israel and which exist in two variants, a Hebrew and a German version, one of which is the original and the other a self-translation. The aim of this study is to compare the versions and their interpretation based on Strauss's theoretical essays on poetry and translation, his political writings and works of literary criticism. Special attention is paid to Strauss's concept (linked with the idea of messianic redemption) of poetry as a "fore-image" of a future true community of men and as "the earthly expression of the Absolute" directed at interpreting divine revelation and its "translation" into human language. In examining Strauss's experiments with self-translation, by which he aimed at establishing a dialogue between languages, and between people and nations, this study considers the two processes of translation: from divine speech into human language and from one human language into another.

Die angeführten Beispiele belegen nicht nur, wie das Göttlich-Weibliche im Großraum Europa wahrgenommen und verehrt wurde, sondern verweisen auch auf ein bevorstehendes, neues Zeitalter im Zeichen des Advents dieses Prinzips. Das Buch offenbart einen in der europäischen Geschichte verborgen liegenden, gemeinsamen Schatz, den es lohnt, zu Tage zu fördern. Es ist ein Muss für jeden informierten und an Selbst-Erkentnis interessierten Leser. Guilty Males and Proud Females is the first complete study on the Bengali gajan festival dedicated to Dharmaraj, a village god in the Rarh region of Bengal. The gajan is the dramatic representation of an hierogamy--the marriage of a god and goddess--and a recreation of the life-cycle of earth. As Fabrizio M. Ferrari explains one of the most fascinating aspects of the gajan is its approach to gender. The central deity of the gajan is a goddess identified with the earth. To please such a goddess, male devotees must acknowledge the pain they inflict towards the female world and become "ritual women." Conversely, as part of the festival, women display their generative power and provoke the jealousy of men by ritually mocking conception and delivery. The outcome of the ritual is that their suffering is acknowledged and transformed into power. Much more than an ethnography of Bengali popular religion, Guilty Males and Proud Females contributes to new studies on gender transformation in the Bengal region and will be of interest to scholars of South Asian religions, folklore, and gender studies.

Anxieties about mothers, says Hildebrandt, separate Eastern from Western imaginations. They separate Freud from Bose, and they separate Hindu foundational texts from the foundational texts of Judaism.

Guilty Males and Proud Females

The face of the divine feminine can be found everywhere in Mexico. One of the most striking features of Mexican religious life is the prevalence of images of the Virgin Mother of God. This is partly because the divine feminine played such a prominent role in pre-Hispanic Mexican religion. Goddess images were central to the devotional life of the Aztecs, especially peasants and those living in villages outside the central city of Tenochtitlan (present day Mexico City). In these rural communities fertility and fecundity, more than war rituals and sacrificial tribute, were the main focus of cultic activity. Both Aztec goddesses and the Christian Madonnas who replaced them were associated, and sometimes identified, with nature and the environment: the earth, water, trees and other sources of creativity and vitality. This book uncovers the myths and images of 22 Aztec Goddesses and 28 Christian Madonnas of Mexico. Their rich and symbolic meaning is revealed by placing them in the context of the religious worldviews in which they appear and by situating them within the devotional life of the faithful for whom they function as powerful mediators of divine grace and terror.

Mit den "Gotteslehrerinnen" gibt Irmtraud Fischer profunde Einblicke in alttestamentliche Geschichten um weise Frauen bzw. in Texte um "Frau Weisheit"

Gotteslehrerinnen

Das Buch behandelt die in der Forschung umstrittene Frage, ob es sich bei der personifizierten Weisheit in der Sapientia Salomonis bereits um eine Hypostase oder lediglich um eine Vorstufe im Sinne einer poetischen Personifikation handelt. Auf die traditionsgeschichtliche Analyse der einschlägigen Weisheitstexte in Prov 1-9, Hiob 28, Sirach 1,1-10 und 24 folgt die Auslegung der zentralen Texte der Sapientia Salomonis (Sap 1,1-10; 7,1-8,1; 9,1-18 und 10,1-11,1). Da in der jüdischen Spätschrift zahlreiche philosophische Anleihen zu finden sind, muss auch im Blick auf den Weisheitsbegriff und das damit verbundene Problem der Vermittlung zwischen Gott und Mensch mit einer Beeinflussung durch die Vorstellungen der zeitgenössischen Philosophie (mittlere Stoa: Poseidonios von Apamea; mittlerer Platonismus: Antiochos von Askalon, Eudoros von Alexandrien) gerechnet werden.

Letztere sind die Adressaten des Spruchebuches. Auf ihre Kronung und Beheimatung ist die Komposition der Proverbien ausgerichtet. Ausgehend von der Internationalität altorientalischer Weisheit nimmt Alexa F. Wilke thematische und strukturelle Vergleiche vor. Sie reflektiert kritisch die von führenden Ägyptologen vorgetragenen Thesen über die (Welt-)Ordnung der Weisheit, die lange den Massstab alttestamentlicher Überlegungen bildeten, und leistet mit ihrer Untersuchung der Proverbien einen Beitrag zur gegenwertigen Diskussion über die Komposition dieser Sentenzensammlung.

Die angeführten Beispiele belegen nicht nur, wie das Göttlich-Weibliche im Großraum Europa wahrgenommen und verehrt wurde, sondern verweisen auch auf ein bevorstehendes, neues Zeitalter im Zeichen des Advents dieses Prinzips. Das Buch offenbart einen in der europäischen Geschichte verborgen liegenden, gemeinsamen Schatz, den es lohnt, zu Tage zu fördern. Es ist ein Muss für jeden informierten und an Selbst-Erkenntnis interessierten Leser. Religiöses Philosophieren in Israel« von Hermann Timm sowie eine Liste mit Weiterführender Literatur zur alttestamentlichen Weisheit, die vom Herausgeber zusammengestellt wird. »Kein Mensch würde auch nur einen Tag leben können, ohne empfindlichen Schaden zu nehmen, wenn er sich nicht von einem breiten Erfahrungswissen steuern lassen könnte« - so beginnt das zu Recht berühmte Weisheitsbuch Gerhard von Rads, das er 1970, also ein Jahr vor seinem Tod, veröffentlicht hat. Weisheit ist praktisches Lebenswissen, nicht Vielwisserei, ein Wissen, das auf - unter Umständen lebenslanger - Erfahrung beruht und dabei hilft, sich in der natürlichen und sozialen Welt zu orientieren und klug, eben »weise«, zu handeln. Von Rad hat diese Lebenskunst mit den zentralen Aussagen des JHWH-Glaubens wie Gottesfurcht, Vertrauen und Schöpfung verbunden und als genuin theologische Angelegenheit entfaltet. Die vorliegende Neuausgabe des länger vergriffenen Alterswerks Gerhard von Rads bietet neben einer kurzen Einführung des Herausgebers den vollständigen Text der Erstausgabe von 1970. Die Weisheit in Israel als einen genuinen Typ des religiösen Denkens zu charakterisieren - das ist es, was von Rad beabsichtigte und die Leser dieses großartigen Buchs noch heute von ihm lernen können. Zielgruppe Studierende und Lehrende der Theologie, speziell des Alten Testaments, die sich mit den Problemen weisheitlicher Theologie auseinandersetzen möchten; PfarrerInnen, ReligionslehrerInnen.

Weiblich - Männlich

Dr. Christiane Northrup gilt international als Kapazität in Fragen der ganzheitlichen Frauenheilkunde. In der Neuauflage ihres Bestsellers hat sie die neuesten Studien und Fallbeispiele zusammengetragen und berichtet mit ihrer reichen Erfahrung aus ihrer Praxis.

Studien zum Menschenbild der älteren Weisheit (Spr 10ff.)

Bernd U. Schipper liest das Sprüchebuch im Kontext der altorientalischen Weisheitsliteratur und zugleich als genuinen Bestandteil des Alten Testaments. Als Literaturwerk aus der Zeit des zweiten Tempels hat das Sprüchebuch Anteil an den theologischen Debatten der Zeit, sei es die Bedeutung der Tora und speziell des deuteronomischen Gesetzes, oder der Frage, ob der Mensch in der Lage dazu ist, gemäß dem göttlichen Willen zu leben. Bei der Analyse altorientalischer Parallelen wird besonders Textmaterial berücksichtigt, das bislang noch nicht für die Auslegung fruchtbar gemacht wurde: die Weisheitstexte aus der ägyptischen Spätzeit (6.–2. Jh. v.Chr.). Insgesamt erweist sich das Sprüchebuch in seiner Endgestalt als eine Schrift aus spätpersischer-frühhellenistischer Zeit, die einem Kreis von »Schriftgelehrten« zugeordnet werden kann, der in den Schriften Altisraels ausgebildet war.

Weisheit in Israel

Philosophie im Sinne von Weisheit hat es eigentlich bis heute noch nicht gegeben. Philos heißt Freund und Sophie heißt Weisheit. Was jedoch die abendländische Philosophie bis heute entwickelt hat, ist eine vernunftbetonte, wissenschaftliche Philosophie, die eigentlich so recht keiner mehr versteht. Ist es da ein Wunder, wenn der Mensch bei dem Wort Philosophie sagt, nein danke, das verstehe ich nicht. Der Weg der Vernunft und der Weg der Weisheit sind beides Erkenntniswege, die bis ins 4. Jahrhundert miteinander konkurrierten. Die eigentliche Suche nach Sophia führt in den mythologischen Bereich, und gerade von diesem wollten die ersten Philosophen sich befreien, in dem sie anfangen die Natur zu erklären.

Weisheit der Wechseljahre

Das weisheitliche Denken ist Bildungsdenken. Im Buch Ben Sira wird erstmals explizit über das Bildungsgeschehen reflektiert und so auch ein Bildungsverständnis erkennbar. Die Studie geht der Frage nach dem Zusammenhang von Weisheit und Bildung nach. Anhand ausgewählter Textpassagen, die ausführlich dokumentiert und unter Hinzuziehung der hebräischen, griechischen und syrischen Textbezeugung textkritisch besprochen werden, kommen die verschiedenen Facetten des Bildungsgeschehens zur Sprache: lebensweltlich in der Frage nach Zielgruppe, Unterrichtsinhalten und -methodik sowie nach Bildungszielen und -hemmnissen; weisheitstheologisch in der Frage nach

den anthropologischen Grundvoraussetzungen, der Rolle des Menschen, der Weisheit und Gottes im Bildungsgeschehen. Zuvor gibt die Studie einen Überblick über die Entwicklung des Schulwesens im Alten Orient und in Griechenland sowie über die Diskussion um Schulen in Israel.

Etude dialectologique de l'aire manding de Côte-d'Ivoire. Fasc. 1.

Die vorliegende Sammlung von Einzelstudien Ulrike Mittmanns zielt auf einen hermeneutischen Neuansatz in der Grundlegung einer Theologie des Neuen Testaments. Neu gegenüber allen bisherigen Versuchen, das Neue Testament einer theologischen Gesamtanalyse zu unterziehen, ist die für alle untersuchten Schriften geltende Verankerung in der alttestamentlich-judischen Weisheit. Die Autorin zeigt, dass die christologische Entwicklung sich im Horizont der alttestamentlich-judischen Weisheit vollzog, die in hellenistischer Zeit alle Bereiche theologischer Reflexion umfassend systematisierte. Die Systematisierung ging einher mit der Ausformung eines binitarischen Gottesbildes, das wegweisend war für die christologische Reflexion des Urchristentums und die spätere Ausbildung eines trinitarischen Gottesbildes.

Deutsche Nationalbibliographie und Bibliographie der im Ausland erschienenen deutschsprachigen Veröffentlichungen

Die in diesem Band beschriebenen Oratorien und Kantaten sind speziell für besondere Konzerte und Veranstaltungen in Kirchen(gemeinden) im Zeitraum von drei Jahren entstanden und uraufgeführt worden. Die meisten Stücke wurden mehrfach aufgeführt. Textschreiberin und Komponist haben sich in enger Zusammenarbeit mit den hier versammelten theologischen Themen auseinandergesetzt. Überwiegend entstand die Musik in Kombination mit poetisch formulierten Texten. Worte wurden vertont und zu Musik, die die Texte in einem besonderen Licht erstrahlen lassen. Philo Sophia und die Liebe zur Weisheit

A collection of 40 or so of the author's essays and contributions to the study of Gnosis, the Mandaeans and Manichaeism, published in the course of the past 40 years. Most have been revised for this new edition. Subjects treated include on the one hand source problems (Nag Hammadi, Manichaean finds and texts, Mandaean manuscripts), and on the other hand the situating of the gnostic-cum-Manichaean tradition in the context of late-antique religious history, especially with regard to the early Christian Church and its environment. Contributions on the history of research set out the issues and problems that have arisen from the study of these texts. Particular attention is given to the new finds from Nag Hammadi, which have proved highly significant for a new picture of Gnosis and Manichaeism.
