The Usual Rules

It's a Tuesday morning in Brooklyn---a perfect September day. Wendy is heading to school, eager to make plans with her best friend, worried about how she looks, mad at her mother for not letting her visit her father in California, impatient with her little brother and with the almost too-loving concern of her jazz musician stepfather. Quality of life (QOL) programs represent a significant investment by the military. Policy-makers need data that will enable them to determine whether QOL programs contribute to positive perceptions of Navy life and impact military outcomes. Ensures observance of field sanitary measures and preventive measures in specialized warfare. Conducts first aid and health education training programs. COURSE DESCRIPTION: During this 8 week course, you will have a mix of classroom and field training. This includes familiarization with USMC organization and procedures, logistics, and administrative support in a field environment.
