Intro

Draw a horizontal line.

Draw a vanishing point on this line, on the right

Draw a rectangle on the left, between the horizontal line.

Draw a tall triangle above.

Draw three lines towards the vanishing point.

Copy the angle of the front roof to the back

Draw a vertical line.

Draw a rectangle to the right, lower and longer than the first.

Draw two more lines towards the vanishing point.

Draw a vertical line and then a horizontal line from the center of the first roof.

Now draw a triangle.

Draw a short straight line, the same angle as the original triangle.

Draw another short straight line, the same angle as the second triangle.

Erase the guidelines.

You could draw a chimney, use the vanishing point for lines going away into the distance.

You could add second chimney.

Windows on walls facing us will be rectangles.

Draw a door on the side and use the vanishing point for the top line of the door

I will just speed up the video for the windows and the shading...

Time to draw some simple details.

Add some shading, for this drawing I am using a 4B pencil.

Each side has just a flat tone to it.

You could add some sketch marks for grasses at the side of a river.

As you draw the grasses, you could draw their reflection too.

Copy the vertical lines down, into the river, using a soft line.

Now add a softer version of the shading on the house to the reflection.

You could add more plants at the edge of the river.

Draw a tall thin tree, next to the house.

You could add more trees to your drawing

He is the author and editor of many books, including *The Adventure of Self-Discovery: Dimensions of Consciousness and New Perspectives in Psychotherapy and Inner Exploration*; *Ancient Wisdom and Modern Science*; *Beyond the Brain: Birth, Death, and Transcendence in Psychotherapy*; *The Cosmic Game: Explorations of the Frontiers of Human Consciousness*; and *Human Survival and Consciousness Evolution*; all published by SUNY Press.

Psychological Territories

Using a creative and poetic modality, Diego Pignatelli explores myth, religion, science and spirituality the liminal territories of modern psychology. On the one hand, greater emphasis on 'subjectivity in anthropology' will lead to newer lines of studies that advance what Robert LeVine called "person centered ethnography," while the greater emphasis on the brain, neuroscience and genomics might fuel studies on epigenetics, plasticity and human growth and maturation in cultural context, or what LeVine has termed the "biocultural" or "biopsychosocial" model of human development. Hybridity fostered by interdisciplinary researchers has stood the test of time as the social sciences have gradually outgrown the monolithic ways of looking at the world. The project of a psychosocial science represented by the work of Robert A. LeVine at the intersection of psychology, anthropology, demography, child development and psychoanalysis maps out some of the challenges of a hybrid discipline. Hybridity impacts not only the humanities and social sciences, but physical sciences in genetics and genomics, or applied disciplines like biotechnology and life sciences. Thus, it is important that we not lose sight of LeVine's spirit of interdisciplinary research. Advocates for universalism, the psychologists or behavioral scientists pursuing universal laws of human nature, must collaborate with the growing number of relativistic scientists - anthropologists, sociologists, or cultural studies experts -- searching for local meanings in small-scale village communities. There will be a confluence of social and human sciences, or what C.P. Snow, the English literary critic called the 'two cultures' of the scientific revolution - the sciences and humanities"--

The Cultural Psyche

My dissertation analyzes "this true inner Africa" in the context of German attempts to achieve self consciousness and Friedrich Nietzsche's critique of the resentment. These chapters establish the pre-Freudian history informing approaches to knowledge of the human in 1913--1914 Vienna, the setting of *The Man without Qualities*. The chapters that follow analyze psychological practices in the novel. I explicate three themes in *The Man without Qualities*: (1) Musil's re-presentation of the vivisectioning of the psyche into moral and primitive territories; (2) his opposition to discourse privileging "superior" bourgeois Europeans as those able to master themselves and others; and (3) his experiment with a "psychology of feeling." The psychology of feeling exposed a complex picture of the world which binaries created by scientists, moralists, and doctors had typically simplified. Musil's experiment with the de-colonization of "this true inner Africa" re-exposes a little known history of psychology that has been overshadowed by Freud's "science."

Robert Musil and the (de)colonization of This True Inner Africa

A simple apple, for example, can be analyzed from several viewpoints beginning with evolution and biology, all the way down its microscopic quantum mechanical components. Is there a reality (or a real apple) out there apart from these maps? How do these various maps interact/intermingle with each other to produce a coherent reality that we interact with? Or do they not? Does our brain use its own internal maps to facilitate "physicist/mathematician" in us to construct the maps about the external territories in turn? If so, what is the nature of these internal maps? Are there meta-maps? Evolution definitely fences our perception and thereby our ability to construct maps, revealing to us only those aspects beneficial for our survival. But the question is, to what extent? Is there a way out of the metaphorical Platonic cave erected around us by the nature? While "Map is not the territory" as Alfred Korzybski remarked, join us in this journey to know more, while we inquire on the nature and the reality of the maps which try to map the reality out there.
