Verdaderos creyentes

En su célebre ensayo homónimo de 1951, Eric Hoffer indagó en la naturaleza del "verdadero creyente", el fanático, y en el activo papel que tuvo en la deriva totalitaria de los movimientos de masas de los años treinta. Fanático es "quien está dispuesto a sacrificar su vida y la de otros por una causa sagrada, una totalidad colectiva o una Arcadia futura". Su sectarismo y férreo dogmatismo, ya sea político o religioso, lo incapacitan para respetar o considerar otro tipo de creencias u opiniones. Más de siete décadas después, la famosa divisa del "piensa como yo o muere" ha tenido y sigue teniendo una triste vigencia. La historia europea contemporánea es elocuente del carácter violento que puede adoptar cualquier movilización política, siendo el terrorismo su expresión por antonomasia: ETA, las Brigadas Rojas o el IRA han dejado miles de víctimas tras de sí. En los últimos años, el terrorismo yihadista, de alcance global, se ha convertido en una de las principales preocupaciones de los medios y de los poderes públicos. Para las ciencias sociales sigue siendo un reto tratar de describir, explicar, predecir y prevenir estos procesos de sectarismo y radicalización violenta. Terrorismo

El terror hizo su aparición en las Ramblas de Barcelona. Repentino y devastador, segó para siempre la vida de personas indefensas. Precisamente porque el terror sume en el desconcierto y parece sustraerse a toda explicación inmediata, resulta indispensable profundizar en la reflexión evitando el reduccionismo de la «locura» o el «fanatismo», que liquidan el asunto de forma expeditiva. El terrorismo actual forma parte de esa guerra civil global, no declarada pero extendida e intermitente, que jalona el tercer milenio. El terror es el rostro oscuro y enigmático de la globalización en guerra. Ninguno de los esquemas a los que suele recurrirse, desde el choque de civilizaciones a la lucha de clases o las guerras de religión, consigue por sí solo esclarecerlo. Pero no ver en el terror un fenómeno político sería una grave equivocación: los terroristas no son nihilistas sin más, pues persiguen un proyecto definido, el del neocalifato global. El pasaje iniciático de la radicalización es un hiato generacional, una ruptura definitiva con los padres, percibidos como traidores. Los hermanos consagrados al terror son huérfanos de raíces, su identidad está rota. Este libro también se pregunta por el fracaso de los proyectos de emancipación que no consiguen calar en esta época desencantada de la modernidad. Di Cesare desentraña magistralmente en esta obra las raíces del terrorismo, las consecuencias del Estado del miedo y el sentido del arma de la propia muerte —sin precedentes en la historia y característico del yihadismo—, no para proporcionar soluciones, sino para tratar de encuadrar el terror planetario, uno de los mayores peligros que a día de hoy enfrenta nuestra sociedad.

Orden y caos entre las naciones

"De pronto, pareciera que nada pudiera sernos ajeno de cuanto acontezca en todos los rincones geográficos, culturales, políticos, comerciales y financieros del mundo. De ahí que, hasta la gente del común, remontando el pensamiento tradicional expresado antes, haya ido adquiriendo una actitud antropológica propensa a lo global, a lo cosmopolita. La evocativa (pero imprecisa) noción de "orden mundial", de pronto, se ha aproximado tanto a nuestra existencia rutinaria que hasta se confunde con la noción doméstica del "orden público". Ambos órdenes permiten concretar nuestro proyecto de vida, y cuando se mantienen en reposo, nos evocan ideas de estabilidad y seguridad, y producen una reconfortante sensación existencial de quietud que nos permite enfocarnos en nuestros quehaceres cotidianos. Pero, precisamente, por ese mismo sentido de inmediatez geográfica del mundo de la posmodernidad (que se convierte progresivamente en nuestro "orden público"), somos más sensibles a la inestabilidad del "orden mundial" y su engendro normativo-institucional: el "sistema internacional". El primero, se ha tornado volátil; el segundo, da muestras de caducidad y amenaza desplomarse. Y esta percepción suscita nuestra imaginación e interés (como intuyendo la gestación de cambios de gran significación histórica), a la vez que hace que nos invada una incómoda y permanente sensación de inquietud, ante la significación de estos cambios en nuestro estilo de vida".

El yihadismo en prisión

La aparición, dentro de la escena criminal, del terrorismo inspirado en una vertiente violenta del salafismo, conocido habitualmente como «terrorismo yihadista», ha supuesto un importante reto para las diferentes instancias estatales con competencias en materia de seguridad. La acción de captación de nuevos integrantes, desarrollada por las redes delincuenciales vinculadas al terrorismo yihadista, en el interior de las prisiones ha provocado que la cárcel se manifieste, no ya como un medio de inocular y/o reinsertar al delincuente juzgado y condenado, sino también como un instrumento capaz de cortocircuitar acciones delictivas aún no cometidas. En la presente obra se analizan las diferentes medidas adoptadas por la Administración española —bien en clave de seguridad, bien en clave de tratamiento— tendentes a evitar la proliferación de los procesos intra-penitenciarios de radicalización violenta, relacionados con este tipo de terrorismo.

Radicalización femenina en España

Vivimos en la era de los populismos. Hemos cambiado la razón por las vísceras y nos han dirigido hacia un debate político de promesas imposibles y de continua violencia. Tras asesinar la libertad y moral privadas el objetivo del populismo es hacer creer que el líder es un salvador y podrá transformarlo todo aportando una solución. Una metamorfosis que nace tras golpear duramente al «otro», al extranjero, al enemigo. El riesgo del populismo, un extremismo ideológico camuflado, es que se acabe transformando en extremismo violento y que devenga en el fanatismo de una minoría contra una mayoría. Populismo Islámico de Antonio de Diego explora el paradigmático caso del populismo en el islam contemporáneo que quizás represente, de forma privilegiada, lo que se ha dado en llamar populismo religioso. Un populismo construido no tanto en la doctrina del islam como en un nuevo modelo de lo islámico centrado en lo ideológico y lo político, de carismáticos líderes y masas manipuladas que anhelan con nostalgia una «Musulmania» que jamás ha existido.

Populismo islámico

No es tarea sencilla definir la realidad en torno al islam en la actualidad. Los intereses mediáticos y el maniqueísmo se imponen por doquier, haciéndonos perder de vista la importancia de saber de qué hablamos cuando utilizamos, sin demasiada conciencia, términos que en principio nos resultan tan familiares como *ihad* (que no *yihad*). A modo de conclusión, se indica que ninguna de las perspectivas explica por sí sola los conflictos, sino que cada una presenta una influencia causal relativa por medio de variables y componentes diferenciados; de este modo, la Teoría de los Marcos de Ruptura (TMR) ahonda en la comprensión de estos episodios violentos a partir de tal enfoque tridimensional. Son los aspectos socioeconómicos vinculados con la redistribución, etnoculturales con el reconocimiento y políticoinstitucionales con la representación, los que están en la base de los estallidos sociales. Esta obra permite entender mejor las causas de estos disturbios que han marcado con sangre y fuego los barrios de estas ciudades. Ver entrevista al autor

Arde la ciudad

La sociología cultural desarrollada por Jeffrey Alexander pretende superar las limitaciones de las teorías de la sociedad y de la acción desarrolladas desde las perspectivas clásicas de la sociología, en las que el papel de la cultura, la ideología, lo simbólico y el significado aparecen como meros reflejos de la estructura o base material de la vida social. En un intento deliberado de situarse en el plano mertoniano de las teorías de rango medio, el resto del libro ofrece diferentes aplicaciones empíricas de esta perspectiva, como son la campaña electoral de Barack Obama y su fracaso simbólico como presidente, el triunfo del movimiento por los derechos civiles, la violencia terrorista del 11 de Septiembre, el fiasco estadounidense en la guerra iraquí o el papel de los intelectuales públicos.

This is the North Korean society that is described in this book. It is one of the last untold stories of Europe's nightmare century, spanning not just the massacre at Rechnitz, the inhumanity of Auschwitz, the chaos of wartime Budapest and the brutalities of Soviet occupation and Stalin's gulags, but also the silent crimes of complicity and cover-up, and the damaged generations they leave behind. Told partly through the surviving journals of others from the author's family and the vanished world of Rechnitz, *A Crime in the Family* is a moving and revelatory memoir in the vein of *The Hare with the Amber Eyes* and *The House by the Lake*. It uncovers barbarity and tragedy but also a measure of peace and reconciliation. Ultimately, Batthyany discovers that although his inheritance might be that of monsters, he does not bear it alone.

Ten years after the 11 September 2001 attacks, jihadi terrorism has largely lost its juggernaut luster. It now mostly resembles a patchwork of self-radicalising local groups with international contacts but without any central organisational design - akin to the radical left terrorism of the 1970s and the anarchist fin-de-siècle terrorism. This volume addresses two issues that remain largely unexplored in contemporary terrorism studies. It rehabilitates the historical and comparative analysis as a way to grasp the essence of terrorism, including its jihadi strand. Crucial similarities with earlier forms of radicalisation and terrorism abound and differences appear generally not fundamental. Likewise, the very concept of radicalisation is seldom questioned anymore. Nevertheless it often lacks conceptual clarity and empirical validation. Once considered a quintessential European phenomenon, the United States too experiences how some of its own citizens radicalise into terrorist violence. This collective work compares radicalisation in both continents and the strategies aimed at de-radicalisation. But it also assesses if the concept merits its reputation as the holy grail of terrorism studies. The volume is aimed at an audience of decision makers, law enforcement officials, academia and think tanks, by its combination of novel thinking, practical experience and a theoretical approach.
