Max Frisch: Dies ist das Buch seines Lebens und seiner Bücher. Volker Weidermann hat sich zu ihm bekannt. »Ich liebe seine Bücher«, schrieb er in »Lichtjahre« über Frisch, und jetzt hat er seine Biographie geschrieben. Die Geschichte eines Jahrhundertlebens und einer ungebrochenen, geheimnisvollen und beglückenden Wirkung. »Wir kennen Max Frisch, wenn wir seine Bücher kennen. Wir kennen seine Frauen und sein Leben, sein Unglück und sein Glück. Schriftsteller sind beliebte Interviewpartner, aus zweierlei Gründen: Man erhofft sich von ihnen Aufschluss über ihre eigenen Werke und Aufklärung über die allgemeine Weltlage. Das Schriftstellerinterview ist eine Fortsetzung der Literatur mit den Mitteln der Mediensprache. Es lebt von der Unmittelbarkeit, mit der sich Schriftsteller zu Wort melden und zu literarischen, gesellschaftlichen und politischen Themen Stellung beziehen. Max Frisch war der Inbegriff eines Schriftstellers, der sich einmischt und gehört wird. Er hat unzählige Interviews gegeben, obwohl er sie eigentlich gar nicht mochte. Umso virtuoser beherrschte er sie: Er war ein master conversationalist, wie sich Jodi Daynard ausdrückt, die ihn in den achtziger Jahren drei Tage lang interviewte. Nun erscheint erstmals eine Auswahl der besten Interviews und Gespräche mit Max Frisch. Einige davon werden zum ersten Mal überhaupt oder zum ersten Mal in voller Länge oder zum ersten Mal in deutscher Sprache veröffentlicht. Im Gespräch über Themen wie Vernunft und Utopie, Ideologie und Kritik, Hass und Gewalt, aber auch über Fakt und Fiktion, Poesie und Polemik werden Fragen beantwortet, die bis heute aktuell sind.

Jetzt ist Sehenzeit

anderen großen Themenkomplexen, wie z.B. der Bildnisproblematik, findet sich in den drei im Rahmen dieser Hausarbeit untersuchten Werken Max Frischs „Der Mensch erscheint im Holozän“, „Homo Faber“ und „Stiller“ auch eine weitere und für das jeweilige Werk wichtige Thematik, in der es um die Rolle der Natur und ihre Auswirkungen auf die einzelnen Charaktere geht. Die Natur kann dabei nicht isoliert betrachtet werden, sondern erhält ihre besondere Bedeutung vor allem durch die Gegenüberstellung mit ihrem Gegenpol: der Technik. Anhand ausgewählter Sekundärliteratur soll im Rahmen dieser Hausarbeit nachgewiesen werden, daß nicht nur die Art und Weise, in der die Oppositionierung von Natur und Technik erfolgt, in allen drei Werken große Ähnlichkeiten aufweist, sondern daß auch die Auswirkungen einer derart gestalteten Gegenüberstellung sich in gewissen Punkten ähnelt. Dadurch ist diese Thematik für die Entwicklung der Charaktere von nicht zu unterschätzender Bedeutung und führt das Leben der Protagonisten gewissermaßen auf den Prüfstand. In diesem Zusammenhang sollen die Reaktionen der jeweiligen Protagonisten auf die Konfrontation mit der Natur untersucht werden und es wird sich dabei zeigen, daß die Reaktionen bestimmte Gemeinsamkeiten besitzen. Dennoch wird eine gewisse Individualität der einzelnen Personen zu erkennen bleiben, bzw. durch die spezifischen Reaktions- und Verhaltensmuster besonders erkennbar.

Der Band enthält, neben einem Abdruck der Rede Max Frisch zum Friedenspreis des Deutschen Buchhandels, vierzehn Studien zum Prosawerk Max Frischs sowie die erste kommentierte Auswahlbibliographie zur Frisch-Literatur. In chronologischem, thematischem, textinternem und vergleichendem Zugriff bieten die Essays und Analysen nicht nur wesentliche Deutungsaspekte zum Prosawerk, sie vermitteln darüber hinaus neue Zugänge zum Werk eines der bedeutendsten Autoren der deutschsprachigen Gegenwartsliteratur. Angesprochen wird nicht nur der Fachmann, sondern auch der weite Leserkreis Frischs, der hier die Weiterführung des Dialogs mit dem Werk finden wird. Der Band vereinigt Arbeiten aus Australien, der BRD, Kanada, der Schweiz und den Vereinigten Staaten. Er wird für den Benutzer aufgeschlüsselt durch ein Namenregister und ein Verzeichnis der Werktitel.

Montauk

Ausgangspunkt dieser Darstellung von Max Frischs Werk ist das berühmte "Tagebuch 1946-1949". Man hat es bisher stets als ein Schriftstellertagebuch wie andere auch gelesen, die genaue Analyse erweist es indessen als ein Werk der Literatur wie Drama und Roman. Darüber hinaus wird deutlich, wie entscheidend die Tagebuchform für Frischs gesamtes Werk ist. Sie ist dessen formales Prinzip und verschmilzt mit verfremdender Darstellungstechnik zu Kunstformen, denen die grossen, immer wieder neu gestalteten Themen Frischs entsprechen : das Missverhältnis zwischen Ich-Wirklichkeit und einseitig festlegender Rolle, zwischen Wahrheit und Bildnis sowie dessen Macht und Gefährlichkeit. Exemplarische Einzelanalysen und zusammenfassende Darstellung verbinden sich zu einem Überblick über Max Frischs schrift-stellerische Entwicklung bis zum "Tagebuch 1966-1971."

Nichts Großartigeres gibt es als das Leben – und nichts Verwickelteres. Dabei hat jede Zeit im Leben ihren ganz eigenen Blick auf die Welt und die Existenz darin. Max Frisch erprobt die Perspektiven und entdeckt in jeder einen ganz eigenen Gewinn. Allen gemeinsam ist ein Bekenntnis: Leben, ja »Für jedes Lebensalter, ausgenommen das kindliche, bedeutet die Zeit ein gelindes Entsetzen, und doch wäre jedes Lebensalter schön, je weniger wir verleugnen oder verträumen, was ihm zukommt.«

Andorra

Die Kernzelle von Andorra findet sich in Max Frischs Tagebuch als Eintragung des Jahres 1946. Andorra ist der Name für ein Modell: Es zeigt den Prozess einer Bewusstseinsveränderung, abgehandelt an der Figur des jungen Andri, den die Umwelt so lange zum Anderssein zwingt, bis er es als sein Schicksal annimmt. Dieses Schicksal heißt in Max Frischs Stück »Judsein«. Das Schauspiel erschien als Buchausgabe zuerst 1961.
